How do we teach phonics?

Listen to stories, retell stories, nursery rhymes and singing.
Language rich environment – spoken and in print

Formal teaching of phonemes (sounds)

Children taught in groups across Year 1 and Year 2 based on their stage of reading

Daily phonic sessions

Handwriting during the session in addition to class handwriting sessions

Additional support for children identified

Regularly review what they have learnt

Taught to apply their phonics in reading and writing

The daily phonics lesson teaches reading, writing, spelling, handwriting and comprehension skills.

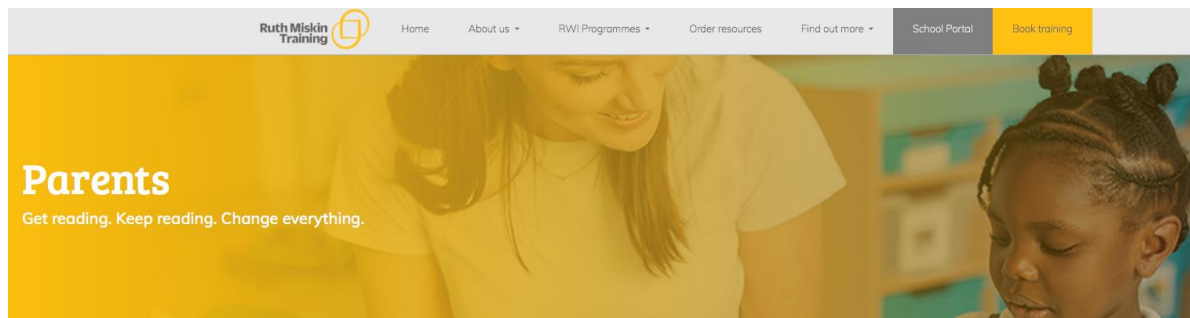
One-to-one tutoring 'keep up, not catch up!'



What can I do?

1. Use pure sounds, not letter names
2. When reading: special friends, sound the word, read the word play ship
3. Use Fred Talk to read and Fred Fingers to spell words
4. Listen to your child read their Storybook every day
5. Read stories to your child every day
6. Enjoy reading with your child
7. * Your child will bring home the handwriting rhymes

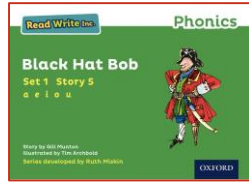

Year 1

Supporting your child at home

Blending Books

Blend together the sounds for up to 8 words each day.

Together make up a sentence with each word. Say it out loud.



Red, Green, Purple, Pink and Orange Books

First read

Front cover - Look at the picture and read the title. Predict what the book could be about.

Inside – practise blending the words before reading. Read the Red Words. Read the story.



Second Read

Inside – practise blending the words before reading . Read the Red Words. Read the story again. Retell the story.

Third Read

Read the story again. Answer the questions.

Yellow, Blue and Grey Books

First Read

As above and vocabulary check.



Second Read

As above and talk about how the story may be the same as other stories you know (character, events, ending).

Third Read

As above, including 2 different types of questions.
