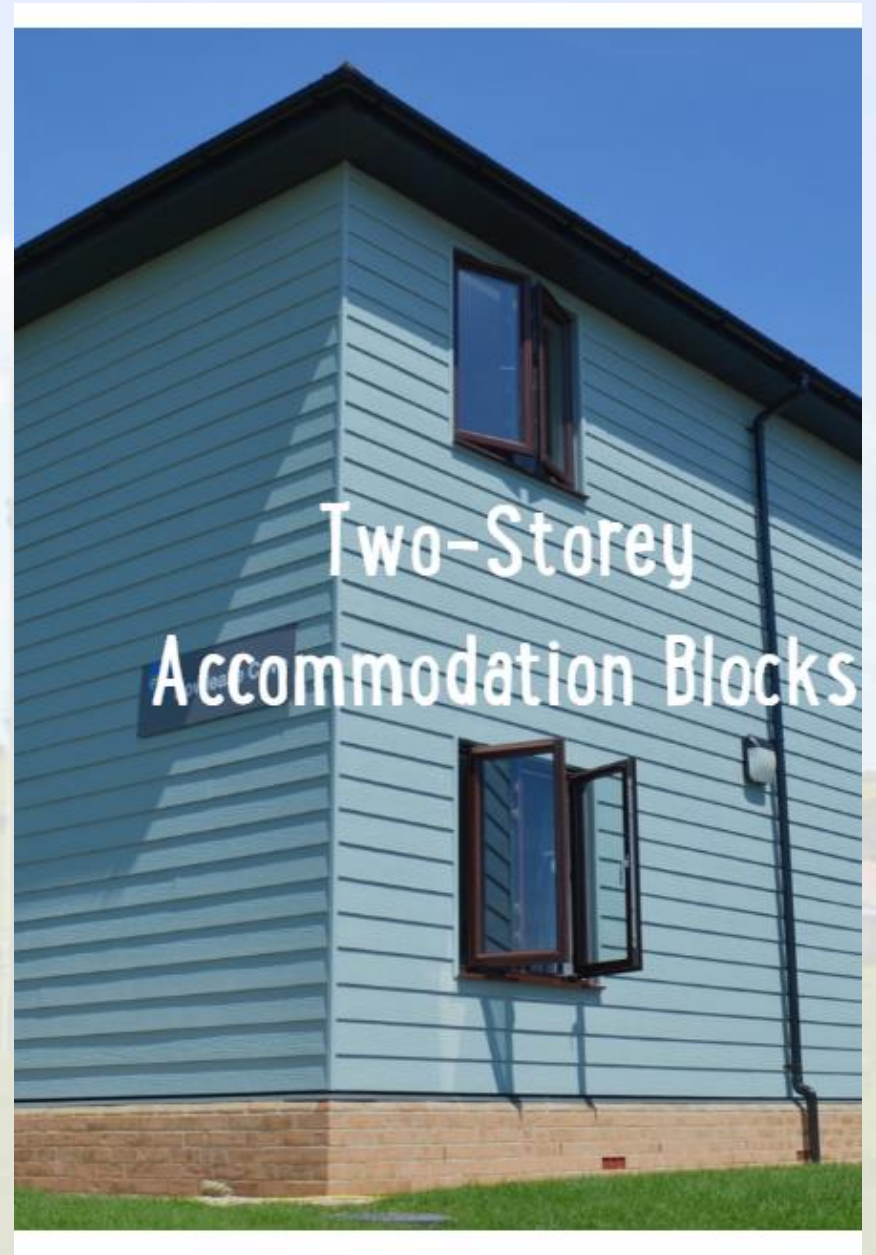

(unless otherwise advised)



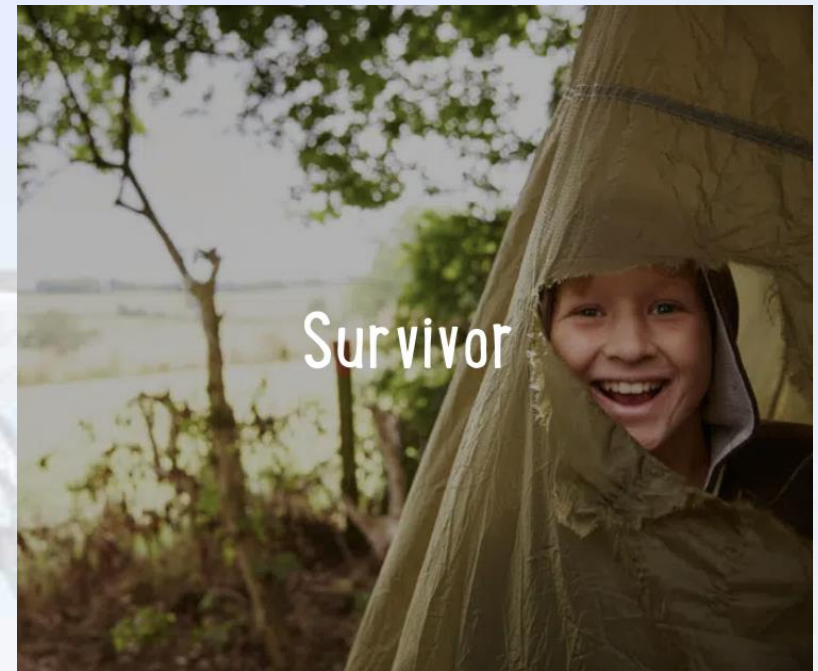
- Washbag** including soap, shampoo, toothbrush and toothpaste (please do not bring Aerosols)
