**Y5 Butser Ancient Farm Trip – Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2026**

Dear Parents/Guardians

As part of our History topic, 'Vikings' we have been able to organise an exciting trip to **Butser Ancient Farm on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2026**. We will become historians participating in activities such as archaeological excavation, artefact handling, pottery and sewing runes.

Children should arrive at school at the **earlier time of 8:30am** (promptly). Children will travel to Butser Ancient Farm by coach, which I am sure will be an exciting experience for them all. We will be leaving Butser at 3pm so this will mean that we will be **back to school at approximately 4.30pm**. If there is a delay, messages will be sent by the office via Arbor.

Children can attend Breakfast Club as normal but will be collected by the Class teacher at 8:30am. After school club are aware of the trip, please speak to them for arrangements if needed.

The children will need to bring a healthy snack (of their choice), packed lunch, including a drink for the day, as well as their water bottle.

If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, Caterlink can provide a packed lunch which includes a sandwich, biscuit/cake and piece of fruit. Your child must wear their school uniform with comfortable shoes (trainers are permitted) and a suitable coat for the weather. Named sun hats and caps can be worn but sun cream must be applied the morning before school.

For this trip to go ahead, we are asking for a voluntary **contribution of £28.00** to cover the entrance charge and coach cost **by Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2026**. Payments can be made via Arbor. Unfortunately, if not enough funds are collected the trip will not be able to take place.

Lastly, please log into Arbor and double-check your child's medical needs are current and up to date. This is extremely important for keeping your children safe. If your child suffers from travel sickness, please disclose this, and complete a medication form at the office for it to be administered.
