**Y2 Windsor Castle Trip – Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June 2026**

Dear Parents/Carers

As part of our summer topic 'What is a Monarch?' we have been able to organise an exciting trip to **Windsor Castle on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June 2026**. The children will get the opportunity to explore the castle and take part in a workshop based on Castles and Monarchs over time.

The trip will take place during the school day so children should arrive at school at the normal time of 8.45am. Children can attend before and after school club as normal.

The children will need to bring a healthy snack (of their choice), packed lunch, including a drink for the day, as well as their water bottle. Your child must wear their school uniform and bring a coat.

If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, Caterlink can provide a packed lunch which includes a sandwich, biscuit/cake and piece of fruit. If you would like your child to have a school packed lunch, please complete the google form, **by Monday 8<sup>th</sup> June 2026** which is accessed using the following link:

Your child must wear their school uniform with comfortable shoes (trainers are permitted) and a suitable coat for the weather. Named sun hats and caps can be worn but sun cream must be applied the morning before school.

We are looking forward to the trip which will enhance and inspire the children's learning both on the day and in the classroom. In order for this trip to go ahead, we are asking for a voluntary **contribution of £14.00** to cover the entrance charge and coach cost **by Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2026**. Payments can be made in instalments via Arbor. Unfortunately, if not enough funds are collected the trip will not be able to take place.

Lastly, please log into Arbor and double-check your child's medical needs are current and up to date. This is extremely important for keeping your children safe. If your child suffers from travel sickness, please disclose this, and complete a medication form at the office for it to be administered.
