EYFS Wellington Country Park Trip – Thursday 11th June 2026

Dear Parents/Carers

As part of our summer topic on minibeasts and life cycles, we are delighted to share we have been able to organise an exciting trip to **Wellington Country Park on Thursday 11th June 2026**. The children will get the opportunity to become a 'Bug Detective' and explore the ancient woodlands to discover magnificent mini-beasts, beautiful butterflies, slimy slugs and more! With farm animals to encounter and a train ride we are looking forward to a fantastic day out.

Children should arrive at school at the normal time of 8.45am (promptly). We will aim to be back at school for the usual collection time of 3.20pm. Children can attend before and after school club as normal. Children will travel to Wellington Country Park by coach, which we are sure will be an exciting experience for them all.

The children will need to bring a healthy snack (of their choice), packed lunch, including a drink for the day, as well as their water bottle. We will also provide a snack. Children can bring these items in a named lunch box which will be collected and stored when we arrive.

As your child is entitled to a Universal Free School Meal, Caterlink can provide a packed lunch which includes a sandwich, biscuit/cake and piece of fruit. If you would like your child to have a school packed lunch, **please order through Arbor by Thursday 4th June 2026 (once the options are available)**.

Your child must wear their school uniform with comfortable shoes (trainers are permitted) and a suitable coat for the weather (as we will be outside). Named sun hats and caps can be worn but sun cream must be applied the morning before school.

We are looking forward to the trip which will enhance and inspire the children's learning both on the day and in the classroom. In order for this trip to go ahead, we are asking for a voluntary **contribution of £28.00** to cover the entrance charge and coach cost **by Monday 8th June 2026**. Unfortunately, if not enough funds are collected the trip will not be able to take place.

Lastly, please log into Arbor and double-check your child's medical needs are current and up to date. This is extremely important for keeping your children safe. If your child suffers from travel sickness, please disclose this, and complete a medication form at the office for it to be administered.
