Beech Class Trip to Braywick Nature Reserve – Thursday 9th July 2026

Dear Parents and Guardians

As part of our Science topic on Plants in the Summer Term, we have organised an exciting trip to **Braywick Nature Reserve on Thursday 9th July 2026**. The Science topic is based on venturing outside and the children will identify names of common and wild plants as well as investigate plants. They will also be able to see edible plants and visit greenhouses. It will be a wonderful first-hand experience.

The trip will take place during the normal school day and to minimise the cost of the trip we request that parents drop off by 9:30am and pick up at 2:30pm to and from the Braywick Nature Reserve.

Please could you complete the below Microsoft form to confirm which adult will be dropping off and collecting your child to and from Braywick Nature Reserve.

The children will need to bring a healthy snack (of their choice), packed lunch, including a drink for the day, as well as their water bottle. Your child should wear their own clothes (non-school uniform) but these must be long trousers, leggings and long sleeved top and suitable footwear for being outside all day. Weather dependant they may need a suitable coat, named sun hats and caps can be worn and if applicable sun cream must be applied the morning before the trip.

If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, Caterlink can provide a packed lunch which includes a sandwich, biscuit/cake and piece of fruit. If you would like your child to have a school packed lunch, please order on Arbor, **by Wednesday 1st July**.

In order for this trip to go ahead, we are asking for a voluntary **contribution of £14.00** to cover cost of the trip **by Friday 3rd July 2026**. Payments can be made in instalments via Arbor. Unfortunately, if not enough funds are collected the trip will not be able to take place.

Lastly, please log into Arbor and double-check your child's medical needs are current and up to date. This is extremely important for keeping your children safe. If your child suffers from travel sickness, please disclose this, and complete a medication form at the office for it to be administered.
